- September Executive Committee Update Second Vote Executive Committee February 4, 2025
- Legislation:
 - First Vote Items:
 - 1. Rule clinic attendance will require the head coach to complete the rules clinic, not another coach on staff.
 - 2. Coaches Ed. Requirement new coach has one year to complete requirements, veteran coach of 10 yrs. must complete 10 hours of continuing education before beginning eleventh year. League websites have approved continuing education opportunities.
 - 3. Grade rule would allow 4 x 4 graduates the same ability to complete the winter season without taking additional courses as spring athletes when finishing spring sport.
 - 4. Transfer rule exception specifies a minimum time a student must attend non-member school before returning to member school to eliminate loophole to regain eligibility. Please note 1) Specifies the student must stay one full year, and 2) the student must meet the nonmember's scholarship requirements or meet the VHSL scholarship requirements.
 - 5. Wrestling contest limit(s) increased number of tournaments allowed from 5 to 8.
 - 6. Cheerleading Add tumbling to handbook language along with stunting to be included in 20-day requirement, clarifies choreography should not be taught until first competition practice date.
 - 7. Drama update handbook for current practice, defines advancement from region/super region format to state tournament.
 - 8. Scholastic Bowl update handbook for current practice, defines advancement from region/super region format to state tournament.
 - 9. Theater adds handbook language to prohibit use of a microphone.
 - 10. Debate in Public Forum, adjusts preparation time from 2 to 3 minutes.
 - 11. Publications update handbook with current procedures for entering publications in the evaluation service.
 - 12. Robotics aligns entry deadline for robotics with published VHSL activities calendar.
 - 13. National Guard Cup changes name of awarding sponsor. Adjusts earning points for film festival for top place finishers and removes sportsmanship due to Claudia Dodson award available.
