- Survey for 4A Field Hockey State Tournament was sent out because 4A is now over the 50% plus 1 threshold. 68 people responded 58 said to hold a state tournament with 55 wanting to do it this year.
- Pepsi is a VHSL Sponsor
- VHSL Coaches Pass registration needs to be sent in as soon as possible
- Physical exam dates are no longer needed on the VHSL Physical. The doctor signature date is what the VHSL will look at for eligibility purposes
- Governance for the Executive Committee for future years with the structure of the VHSL will be changing. Regional reps are asked to think about how to limit the Executive Board members and ideas that may help do this.
- Sports Turf has a purchasing contract with the VHSL
